- ✓ See a healthcare provider 4-6 weeks before your trip.
- ✓ Avoid bites from mosquitoes and other bugs.
- ✓ Stay safe around animals.
- ✓ Be safe on international roads.
- ✓ Wash your hands often with soap and water and use a hand sanitizer, as needed.



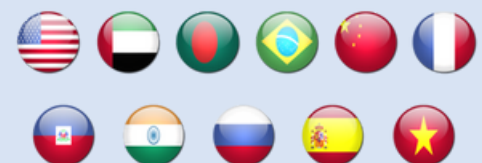
